

REVIEW EXPORTS DURING 2016-17 (APRIL- MARCH) *

According to the provisional data available the exports of Handicrafts have shown an increase of Rs. 2973.13 crores, from Rs. 21557.12 to Rs. 24530.25 crores, an increase of 13.79% in rupees term. In dollar terms, the exports have shown the increase of US \$ 364.55 millions i.e. the exports increased by 11.07% over the similar period in 2015-2016. Details are as under: -

During the period, the exports of Art Metalware, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted goods, Shawls as artwares ,Attar and agarbaties and Misc. Handicrafts showed an increasing trend of 21.96%, 29.04%, 8.44%, 30.52%, 9.38% and 29.71% in rupees terms respectively while Woodwares, Zari & Zari Goods and Imitation Jewellery showed a negative growth of 4.52%, 6.50% and 14.07 % respectively. In USD terms Art Metalware, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted goods, Shawls as artwares, Agarbaties & Attars and Misc. Handicrafts have shown an increasing trend of 19.04%, 25.96%, 5.85%, 26.79%,6.76% and 26.61% while Woodwares, Zari & Zari Goods and Immitation Jewellery showed a negative growth of 6.80%, 8.76% and 16.12%. Overall an increase in the rupee term was 13.79% and in the US \$ term was 11.07%.

REVIEW EXPORTS DURING 2017 (APRIL) *

According to the provisional data available the exports of Handicrafts have shown an increase of Rs. 253.58 crores, from Rs. 1730.57 to Rs. 1984.15 Crores, an increase of 14.65% in rupees term. In dollar terms, the exports have shown the increase of US \$ 47.23 millions i.e. the exports increased by 18.14% over the similar month in 2016. Details are as under: -

During the period, the exports of Artmetalware, Woodware, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted Goods, Shawls as artwares , Zari & Zari Goods, Immitation Jewellery, Aggarbatii & attars and Misc. Handicrafts showed the increasing trend of 13.84%, 9.45%, 18.72%, 17.32%, 15.79%, 21.41%, 13.38%, 20.57% & 14.47% respectively. In USD terms, Artmetalware, Woodware, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted Goods, Shawls as artwares , Zari & Zari Goods, Immitation Jewellery Aggarbatii & attars and Misc. Handicrafts showed the increasing trend of 17.29%,12.77%,22.33%,20.88%,33.33%,24.68%,16.80%,24.28% & 17.97% respectively. Overall an increase in the rupee term was 14.65% and in the US \$ term was 18.14%.
