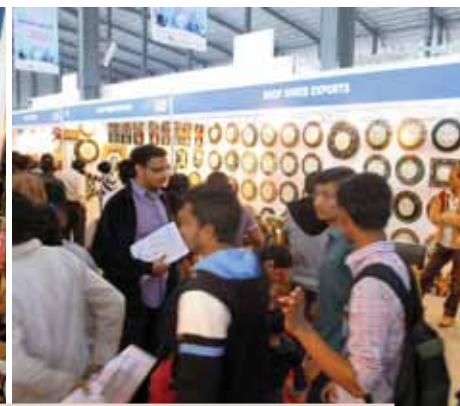
The 7th Vibrant Gujarat Global Trade Show 2015, held at The Exhibition Center, Near Mahatma Mandir, Helipad Ground, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, was jointly organized by Industrial Extension Bureau (iNDEXTb), a Govt. of Gujarat organization and M/s. K and D Communication Ltd. The show spread over an area of 1, 25,000 sq. mtr. , distributed into 15 halls showcasing over 25 sectors and providing an opportunity to bring together, policy makers, decision makers, consultants, technology providers and top professionals at a single platform. Along with the Vibrant Gujarat Global Trade Show (VGGTS), the Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD), was organized from 7-9 January, 2015 and Vibrant Gujarat Global Investors Summit was organized from 11-13 January, 2015.
