Autumn International Fair is a B2B fair spread over in 52000 sq. mtrs. area and widely visited by approx. 25000 visitors and volume buyers from UK and from across the globe. Council's participation to China International Furniture Expo

Shanghai, China; 11th - 15th September 2023

EPCH participated in the China International Furniture Expo, held at Shanghai, China from 11th - 15th September 2023. The Council led a representation of 20 member exporters and also set up a Publicity Booth to promote IHGF Delhi Fair-Autumn, specifically IHGF Delhi Fair - Furniture and VRIKSH Certification Scheme.

Mr. Dileep Baid, Chairman, EPCH, also interacted with the member exporters participating in this show. He had a meeting with Dr. N Nandakumar, Consul

General of India, Shanghai, China and briefed him about the Council's activities. The discussion was held on various points including barter with Chamber of Commerce in China, CCPIT, Online Marketing, Warehouse in China, Japan & Korea, Technology upgradation support, Permanent shop in YIWU for Indian Handicrafts, Trade study & promotion, etc.

The first edition of China International Furniture Expo (also known as Furniture China) was co-hosted by the China National Furniture Association and Shanghai Sinoexpo Informa Markets International Exhibition Co., Ltd. in 1993. Since then, Furniture China was held in Shanghai in the second week of every September. Since its establishment, Furniture China has been successfully held on 27 occasions, making common growth and progress with the furniture industry in China. At the same time, it has transformed from a pure B2B offline trade platform to a comprehensive platform integrating export, domestic sales, B2B2P2C online and offline, original design

This was the 28th edition co-located with the 2023 Modern Shanghai Fashion Home Exhibition, with an exhibition scale of 320,000 square meters, 2,635 global high-quality exhibitors (including Modern Exhibition, 313 companies), showing the world the Chinese furniture industry and furniture people. ■
