


EPCH celebrates 78th Independence Day with a special sapling planting drive 15th August 2024

Free Eye Check up & General Health Check-up camp

A Free Eye and General Health Check-up Camp was organized at the Common Facility Centre (CFC) Saharanpur by the Moradabad Charitable Trust & Health Research Centre, in collaboration with the Saharanpur Handicrafts Artisans Welfare Trust and the Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts (EPCH), with medical support from Asian Vivekananda Super Specialty Hospital and Centre for Sight Eye Hospital.

The camp was inaugurated by Dr. Ajay Kumar Singh, Mayor of Saharanpur, as the chief guest. The inauguration, marked by a ribbon-cutting ceremony, was attended by Mohd.
