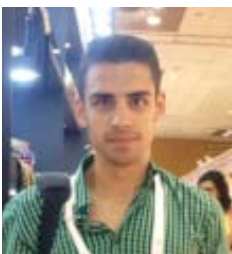
Items of Interest : Handcrafted Accessories
