

OVERVIEW

- Wall coverings create bold statements as immersive patterns and macro motifs come to the fore
- Designs bring a vivid sense of nature indoors, from exotic climates and wild forests to rich florals and delicate branches

BRANCH OUT

Wallpaper designs bring a sense of nature indoors with large-scale branch and vine designs. Branches unfurl and flourish with blooms or create graphic vertical structures encompassing the whole space for a fresh update on nature-inspired designs. Designs create a cocooning, immersive effect for residential and commercial interiors.

TROPICAL CLIMES

Designs look to tropical climates for inspiration, ranging from lush super-size leaves to compositions populated by monkeys, parrots and elephants. Bright contrasting colourways create statement wall coverings that evoke lush exotic environments within interior spaces, and are paired with both modern and classical interior styling.



FLORAL BOUQUET

Dense-coverage floral compositions continue to play an important part in wallpaper designs, in patterns that range from 1950s floral bouquets to Scandinavian folk florals and contemporary stylised motifs. Designs are maximalist, and are therefore paired with solid-colour floors, walls and furniture to complement intricate and vividly coloured designs.





LUSH LEAVES

Lush leaf designs are creating immersive natural environments for home interiors, with darkly dramatic, *dense foliage* and delicate botanical prints alike. Leaf forms and details such as veinings are celebrated in stylised graphic shapes and delicately painted details.



NATURAL MATERIALS

Wallpapers are also inspired by the ongoing trend towards *natural* surfaces, with stone, wood and composites featuring in fresh designs. Sharply modern renditions create realistic material-led backgrounds for interiors, as an affordable substitute to the material itself. Some designs are hand-drawn or stylised to create an interpretation that is more artistic than photographic.

BOLD STRIPES

Striped wallpapers offer striking definition within interior spaces. Vertical and horizontal lines at macro scales define zones within rooms, from graphic monochrome bands to hazier and more blurred lines alternating between tones of colour. Ombré shifts and metallic pigments add to the powerful overall look.



TRELLIS STRUCTURE

Trellis motifs continue to be popular, with variations offering a more hand-drawn aesthetic than previous iterations. Designs range from classical to arabesque, with simple yet elegant lines and patterns offering a muted accent backdrop in commercial and residential spaces. Colours range from light and muted to vibrant teal, rich blue and dramatic gold for a ReMaster-inspired story.
