EPCH set up a theme participation of crafts from the North East Region with artisans, entrepreneurs & member exporters and a product profile comprising furniture, cane & bamboo crafts, home textiles, areca palm plates, lamps & lighting, etc., suited to living spaces in the hospitality world. These north-eastern states were well-represented in the B2B show, giving them an opportunity to showcase a variety of products, from bamboo furniture to organic ginger and turmeric, to kiwi wine from Arunachal Pradesh.
